Ms. Britt responded that all installations would have to comply but that language could be added for specificity.</p> <p>Ms. Britt then distributed some language regarding solar panels that she had found in other city codes, i.e. Dublin, GA, Fort Mill, and Rock Hill.</p> <p>Mr. Burns also stated that the battery storage capacity should be considered when discussing the building code requirements.</p> <p>Mr. Church asked that language be looked at regarding the shielding of ambient light pollution as well.</p> <p>Chris Leonard suggested that any further discussion be deferred on the Code revisions until the Feb. 13 meeting so that the Commission could review the suggested changes. A Joint Public Hearing could then be scheduled for the March 20, 2017 Council Meeting with first reading of the revised ordinance.</p>
