## NEWCOMER INFORMATION

**Animals:** Dogs must be on a leash. Call York County Animal Control if dogs are running at large @ 327-8381. Dogs are banned from beach areas from May 1 - September 30.

**Building/Renovation/Construction:** Requires a City Permit. Docks, etc. require a City permit and Duke Energy permit. All fences require a City permit, except invisible fences. Cutting any standing tree (alive or dead) 4" or larger in diameter requires a City permit. A permit is required for swimming pools, **roofing**, spas **and** storage buildings. **Contractors must possess a City Business License and a SC Contractors License.** Any construction on City-owned common land areas (greenbelts, greenways) requires a permit. Applications @ City Hall or on the City of Tega Cay website.

**Business and Practices:** A Business License is required if business is located or selling goods or services within the City. Door-to-door solicitors must have a Business License and register with the Police Department. Applications @ Development Services or on website.

**Garbage:** Placed at curbside by 6 a.m. for pickup on Monday or Tuesday. Garbage roll carts should be placed at curbside no earlier than sundown the day before garbage pickup and must be removed from curbside within 24 hours of garbage pickup.

**Recycling:** Placed at curbside by 6 a.m. every other Friday of the Month (see website). Check cover of recycle container for acceptable items. All material must be broken down and placed inside the cart.

**Yard-Waste:** The City will pick up brush, leaves, etc. the beginning of each week. Place on the curb Sunday evenings.

You are encouraged to make arrangements with charitable organizations, for pickup of ranges, refrigerators, etc. or call City Hall for fee schedule.

**Maintenance of Property:** Building materials, rubbish, and unregistered vehicles are not permitted on occupied or vacant lots. The parking of campers, recreational vehicles, boat and water craft trailers is permitted in residential driveways with a 72-hour parking permit issued by the city. Such parking permits must be posted on the vehicle and are limited to four renewals within a 30-day period. Parking on public property is prohibited unless signs are otherwise posted and/or written permission is granted for a temporary variance. Storage space can be leased in the lot near the Police Department by calling City Hall @ 803-548-3512.

**Recreation:** Recreation Office is located in the Beach & Swim Center office, 803-548-3787.

**Speed limits:** 20 mph, unless otherwise posted.

**Vehicles:** Must be registered in South Carolina within forty-five days in Newport or Fort Mill. Contact the Division of Motor Vehicles at [www.scdmvonline.com](http://www.scdmvonline.com) for information. **Drivers Licenses** must be obtained within ninety days. **Tega Cay Parking Stickers** are required at Windjammer Park, Pitcairn Park and the Beach & Swim Center. Parking Stickers may be obtained @ City Hall.

**Elections:** City elections are held the 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday following the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in November of odd years. Call 803-684-1242 or [www.yorkcountygov.com](http://www.yorkcountygov.com) for more information.

**Voter Registration:** Register at the DMV, York County Voter Registration office or online.
