How to Register

A citizen who wishes to register to vote may:

- **REGISTER ONLINE www.scvotes.org**
 - Requires S.C. Driver's License or DMV ID
 - The online application will allow you to register at your DMV residence address
 - If you have moved, you must first update your residence address with DMV
- Register in person at their county board of voter registration, or
- Download a form, complete it, and mail it to their county board of voter registration, or
- Download a form, complete it, and fax it to their county board of voter registration, or
- Download a form, complete it, scan it, and email it as a file attachment to their county voter registration office.

Voter registration is closed for 30 days prior to any election. For example, the voter registration deadline for a November 5th election would be October 5th. The last day to register to vote for a Tuesday election is always on a Saturday.

- Online applications must be submitted on or before the deadline to be valid for any specific election. Online voter registration does not "turn off" at the deadline. Applications submitted after the deadline will be processed but will not be valid for that particular election.
 - Fax and email applications must be received by the voter registration office by the deadline to be valid for a particular election. Applications received after the deadline will be processed but will not be valid for that particular election.
 - Mail-in applications must be postmarked by the deadline. Most registration deadlines fall on a Saturday. Check with your local post office about receiving a Saturday postmark.
