Scam Alert

If you haven't received a call from someone claiming to be from the IRS, then you are one of very few. [These types of scams](#) are prevalent and annoying...not to mention dangerous for those unsuspecting victims. This past week, dozens linked to the IRS scams were arrested. [You can read the story here.](#) Additionally, this week some Duke Energy customers were receiving e-mails claiming to be from Duke Energy with outage Information. Also a scam, but especially tricky timing with Hurricane Matthew having just blown through. Duke Energy issued a warning urging customers to "be careful before opening any e-mails and ensure you know the sender. To avoid this problem, you can register for your proactive active outage notification service by texting REG to 57801. If your mobile phone number is NOT associated with your account, you will receive a return text asking you to go to a secure online site to sign up."
