AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX D (ORDINANCE 484) OF THE CITY’S CODE AS IT RELATES TO TOWING FEES

WHEREAS, the City of Tega Cay does have an established Police Department charged with enforcing the laws of the City and State including vehicular related matters;

WHEREAS, Appendix D of the City’s Code addresses the fee schedule for towing of vehicles on police calls; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to update the fees outlined in Appendix D to ensure services can be acquired through Wrecker/Tow companies and such companies are charging standard rates similar to surrounding jurisdictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the City Council of the City of Tega Cay does hereby adopt this Ordinance in its entirety to amend Appendix D to the following:

Wrecker charges on police calls.

1. Maximum charges:
 - a. Class A Wrecker
 - i. Standard Towing: \$257.00
 - ii. Storage: \$43.00 per day
 - b. Class B Wrecker
 - i. Standard Towing: \$363.00
 - ii. Storage: \$53.00 per day
 - c. Class C Wrecker
 - i. Standard Towing: \$528.00 per hour*
 - ii. Storage: \$69.00 per day
2. Additional fees
 - Use of go-jacks: Maximum \$20.00
 - If vehicle has to be overturned off the road or extensive winching is required:
 - Maximum for normal overturn vehicle: \$20.00
 - No more than \$150.00 based on extra equipment or extenuating circumstances.
 - Vehicle notification after six days of storage: Maximum 50.00
3. Fee to reopen towing facility after normal business hours (8:00 a.m.—5:00 p.m., Monday—Friday), maximum35.00




