

Youth Sports Participants,

As we begin open fall registration, we wanted to follow up on the email sent on May 13th regarding the potential price increase of recreation sports and how it may affect those living outside the Tega Cay city limits.

The City of Tega Cay, along with other municipalities in York County, worked tirelessly to ensure the recreation funding model remained in place to continue providing high quality programming at an affordable cost for all participants. We understand increased registration costs may create varying levels of financial strain on our non-resident participants and impact valued members of our recreational community.

Unfortunately, York County Council recently voted to eliminate funding used to offset costs associated with active recreation programming provided by municipalities. In place for 20 years, this funding allowed participants living in the county, but outside of Tega Cay, to pay the same rate as city residents. The alternative funding model offered by the County reflects a substantial reduction from previous years and uncertainty in sustainability. York County Council's decision to eliminate the long-standing partnership and funding agreement directly correlates to no longer allowing us to charge the same rates.

Should County Council choose to reinstate the previous funding, we would anticipate returning to our original fee structure. We recommend contacting your county representative if you would like to voice your concerns or share how their decision affects you.
