General Information & Rules

The 2022 Tega Cay Catawba Fest will be an outdoor affair, held at Catawba Park from 11:00 am – 8:00 pm. We will feature live music, children's games, food, and arts & crafts.

Registration

- Vendors will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Final placement of all vendors is at the discretion of the City Events Manager.
- Registration forms/payments to participate in the festival must be received within two weeks of confirmation or your confirmed spot will be released.
- Payment must be submitted to Tega Cay City Hall located at 7725 Tega Cay Dr., Tega Cay, SC 29708. Checks can be made payable to CITY OF TEGA CAY CATAWBA FESTIVAL. Please note the name of your business on the check.
- Any registration forms received after October 10th, 2022, will be waitlisted.
- Cancellations will be accepted for a refund until Monday, October 10th, 2022. No refunds will be provided for cancellation after this date.

501c3

- A limited number of spaces will be available for nonprofit 501(c) 3 and community organizations. Must provide proof of status at application.
- Nonprofit 501(c) 3 organizations will not be allowed to sell merchandise/food. Must display tax ID number and/or certification at booth.
- Community organizations that are not 501 (c) 3 may display organizational materials only.

Cancellations

- An application is a commitment to show. No refunds will be given after 10/10/22. If you need to cancel, please notify Kaity Brzostowicz in writing before the refund deadline. If you cancel prior to the deadline, you will receive a refund minus 20%. If you cancel after the deadline, booth fees will be forfeited

Set Up

Please see the schedule below for set-up times. Break down may begin at 7:30PM. All food vendors must remain open until 8:00 pm.

- DJ BrownSound – 11:00 AM-8:00 PM
- Arts, Craft and Local Business Vendors - 11:00 AM-8:00 PM
- Live Music – 2:00 PM-8:00 PM
- Kids Zone – 11:00 AM-6:00PM
- Vendors are responsible for bringing and setting-up their own equipment (tables, chairs, tents, etc.).
- Your booth must not interfere with adjacent exhibits in any way. All your display, including chairs, must be placed within the confines of the space. Nothing is to be placed in the aisles, or another artist's booth.
- Please be prepared to properly secure your tents with stakes, blocks, or sandbags.
- Electric Connections – All vendors are required to provide their own power if needed. **SILENT GENERATORS ONLY.**

General Rules

- All vendors must be in compliance with South Carolina Department of Revenue standards for their business.
- Photos taken by the City may be used in the future for programs or advertisements.
- For the safety and enjoyment of everyone – **NO PETS ALLOWED**
- Sponsors and exhibitors/food vendors may not switch, sublet or apportion spaces to other exhibitors or food vendors.
- Food Vendors are responsible for acquire proper permitting from York County Health Department.
- To be fair to all vendors, no food is to be given away by nonprofits or vendors.
